



Calvin Center Annual Benefit Trail Ride-September 25, 2010

Rules and Regulations

1. Riders must bring own horses. Horses will not be provided by Calvin Center.
2. All participants must be registered.
3. Management reserves the right to qualify rider's ability and to excuse any rider from activity beyond their skill level.
4. Riders must be 12 years of age or older. All riders under 18 must be accompanied by an adult and must wear a helmet. There must be at least one adult to accompany every two minors. Minors should not be left unattended.
5. Riders will be required to wear long pants and appropriate closed toed shoes. If riding w/o safety stirrups, boots must have 1/2 inch heel and flat sole. If peacock stirrups, tapaderos or Devonshire boots are being used, riders may ride in tennis shoes.
6. No alcoholic beverages or smoking permitted on Calvin Center property.
7. All riders must stay behind the trail boss and in front of the drag/end rider. Riders must stay on designated trail route.
8. Pre-trail ride warm up permitted only in areas designated for warm up.
9. No rough riding or racing permitted. Canter/loping allowed in open fields/meadows only and not on narrow trails.
10. No stallions or green horses. Please do NOT use this ride as a training opportunity for your young horse.
11. No ponied or loose horses. All horses must be ridden.
12. Only one rider/horse. No double riding.
13. No pets.
14. Motorized vehicles will not be allowed on the trails.
15. Park trailers and vehicles in designated areas only.
16. Riders must be able to ride without the assistance of others.
17. Horses prone to kicking must wear a red ribbon on the top of their tail.
18. All horses should be properly fit and conditioned.
19. Hooves must be properly trimmed or shod to walk on dirt trails.
20. No horse will be allowed on the premises without proof of negative Coggins.
21. No firearms or fireworks
22. Riders are responsible for bringing own hay and water buckets. Do not use Calvin Center watering troughs. Fill buckets at spigots.
23. Clean up after your horses in parking area.
24. All riders must complete liability release, medical release, photography release and registration. Riders choosing not to wear a helmet must sign helmet waiver.
